Meeting 7-20-16

Called to order by Chief Davidson at 0832 hours. The Chief asked for a moment of Silence in honor of Joe Zangaro and Ron Kienzle who perished while performing their duty on July 11th.

ATTENDANCE:

COMMITTEE REPORTS

911 – Dave updated the group on the Text to 911 system . Verizon having issues with maps. T-Mobile should be on in August.

Priority Changes passed on to Dr. Byers. Dr. Finch didn't address it at the last meeting.

Sawyer site antenna work being conducted next week. MPSCS still must approve Grand Beach updates. Sawyer maint – Gabe said he would try to keep the system in operation by using the spare antenna.

Active Violence Incident Plan was discussed. Did discuss the call at the Q&A meeting on Wednesday. AVI –Active Violence Protocol used right away. Dispatch was fully staffed at the time of the event. This allowed staff to keep the caller on the line. The incident as you can imagine was very chaotic and Dispatch must take information and get it out to LE and other responders accurately. Security Staff at the Court were able to take control of the situation very quickly. If not Dispatch would have activated the Mass Recall of fire resources. Chief Davidson commended dispatch for their handling of this tragic event.

If you didn't get a text from Dave on the past event please give him a call. Information was not put out over ComSouth. Dave also discussed the issues caused by the media calling dispatch. Rockey said that the PIO was set up but the National Media are not normally in our system. Dave cautioned that we would have had a different call in a school or unprotected building with high risk. Finally thanks to Benton Twp and St Joe City Fire for their Flag at the funerals.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT/LEPC – May take several months to get all of the information out on the incident. Press Conference was pushed out till Friday. Interview techniques take time to get quality information. A policy review will be conducted in the upcoming weeks to prevent this in the future. Rockey discussed his pleasure with all of the help they received with the funerals. Not used to turning away help. It is important in our work to show brotherhood. This process showed that we are one big team. LT Dan Jewell will be hosting training on August 3rd designed for recert class. Open to the Fire Departments. 100% ID Check with no weapons.

Emergency Response Guidebooks are in. Numbers were selected by the State.

EMS- .Medic 1 - Discussed Court response. A simple tourniquet applied to Officer Atterberry allowed him to go from Red to Green. Law Enforcement are carrying and trained in tourniquet. Dave added that the Comms plan will tone out departments but it is important to develop preplans with LE to deploy. It was also added that pedestrians can quickly become a hazard at these types of events.

SMCAS – Frank discussed events at Red Bud. Thanks for all the help from partner agencies.

MedFlight – Ken added that Safety LZ OPS classes are available.

Chief Koebel of Royalton Twp thanked Medic for their recent assistance at a fire scene.
