Extensive discussion on 11BCPAGE. Most agencies have it in radio/pager and/or both. Frank motioned dispatch start using 11BCPAGE immediately. Decision that dispatch will start using 11BCPAGE on February 01, 2023. Reminder 11BCPAGE is NOT a paging talkgroup. Departments DO NOT need 11BCPAGE to be dispatched. Weather you have 11BCPAGE in your radios/pagers or not, will not change/effect the way you get dispatched. Departments WILL still get dispatched via their normal paging talkgroup (11PGXX##). Having 11BCPAGE allows you to get the HEADS UP (noisy neighbor) and hear the other agencies get dispatch.

21. New business – Discussion on amending the bylaws as the new bylaws do not address the issue of unable to hold nominations/elections due to lack of quorum. Suggested adding Article 10.5: If unable to hold nominations at the November meeting and/or elections at the December meeting due to lack of quorum, or any other unforeseen circumstances, nominations and elections are to take place at the next regularly scheduled association meeting. To be discussed again at the January meeting as a 30 day notice is needed to change amend bylaws and January meeting is before the 30 day notice.
