Meeting called to order at 19:21 hours by President Gerry Kabelman.

Roll of officers present: President Gerry Kabelman,1<sup>st</sup> Vice President Dave Albers, and Secretary/Treasurer Dennis Graham. 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President Craig Brent was absent.

A bill for \$326.81 was also presented by Bruce Stover for the Korn Dog meal. A motion made by Denny Sexton and supported by Frank DelLaTorre to pay the amount. Motion carried.
