



Health and Safety Program Manager



This two-day course will provide fire and emergency medical services department personnel and other related emergency responders with the aptitudes and abilities necessary to manage the duties and responsibilities of the Health and Safety Program Manager (HSPM) within their respective organizations. This course will enable the student to identify and analyze health and safety aspects that affect emergency responder safety in both emergency and non-emergency situations. Risk analysis, wellness, program management, and other occupational safety issues are the main emphasis of the course.



This course is pre-approved by the Michigan Bureau of EMS, Trauma & Preparedness for EMS Continuing Education credits, for all levels.

The **St. Joseph Township Fire Department – Station # 1** is going to be hosting this firefighter training course that is Michigan – Office of Fire Fighters Training (OFFT) certified.

Each firefighter that attends and completes the course will be issued a certificate from the OFFT. This course will take place at the St. Joseph Township Hall, 3000 Washington Avenue, St. Joseph, MI 49085.

 - Sunday, February 26th; from 8:00am – 4:30pm
- Student requirements: Must be a member of an Organized Fire Department
