



Traffic Incident Management



The VFIS Traffic Incident Management (TIM) program is designed to help emergency responders minimize the risk of responding on or near a highway by understanding the elements of a safe work zone and recognizing the potential hazards in operating on or near a highway. The program covers a variety of items, including the need for advanced warning, apparatus positioning and placement, multi-agency communication, scene lighting, retro-reflective and fluorescent personal protective equipment and coordination of on-scene apparatus and personnel.

The **St. Joseph Department of Public Safety** is going to be hosting this firefighter training course that is Michigan – Office of Fire Fighters Training (OFFT) certified. Each firefighter that attends and completes the course will be issued a certificate from the OFFT. This course will take place at the St. Joseph Fire Station, 923 Board Street, St. Joseph, MI 49085.
