## ICS 400 Advanced ICS Command and General Staff Complex Incidents

<b>Description:</b>	<p>This course provides training on and resources for personnel who require advanced application of the Incident Command System (ICS). This course expands upon information covered in the ICS-300 course. The course objectives are to explain how major incidents engender special management challenges, describe the circumstances in which an area command is established and describe the circumstances in which multiagency coordination systems are established.</p> <p>NOTE: The maximum class size is 28.</p>		
<b>Target Audience:</b>	Senior personnel who are expected to perform in a management capacity in an area command or multi-agency coordination entity.
