

Mutual Aid Tanker Shuttle Training



This course is designed to give the Fire Fighter a basic understanding of Water Tanker Apparatus construction and function, understanding of loading and unloading methods, construction pre-fire survey, accessing incident fire flow demand and the design tanker apparatus evolutions to meet incident demand.

The **Weesaw Township Fire-Rescue** will be hosting the above listed firefighter training course, that is State of Michigan – Bureau of Fire Services (BFS) certified. Each firefighter that completes the course and passes the Course Exam will be issued a certificate from the BFS.
