

AWR 144: Port and Vessel Security for Public Safety and Maritime Personnel

AWR 144 is an 8-hour, DHS/FEMA-certified, tuition-free, awareness level course developed to introduce small, rural, and tribal agency first responders to the maritime security requirements of high-risk, regulated facilities in their jurisdictions. In emergencies, regulated facilities have federally-mandated security and reporting procedures that must be followed. Management of an incident will be more efficient when emergency responders have a good working knowledge of maritime security principles and procedures.

Topics include (but not limited to):

- Characteristics of the U.S. Marine Transportation System
- Threats to the U.S. Marine Transportation System
- Maritime regulations and safety issues
- Facility Security Plan and MARSEC levels
- Resources for interfacing with facilities and vessels

This course is designed to give practical information to local responders and marine stakeholders who might be called upon to respond to maritime incidents. The primary audience for this course includes personnel from:
